

Ensemble Commitment & Financial Responsibility

Ensembles rehearse during a class time specified just for ensemble during the week. Only **two** ensemble rehearsals can be missed per semester.

Tuition: \$30 more per month will be added for class

Ensembles will attend two or three competitions during the year as well as perform at the Red River Revel and other civic performances that become available.

Example of fees per competition as follows:

\$180 Convention Fee- per convention

\$25-\$30 Competition Fee- per dance

\$80 Wind suit including T-shirt- ordered in Fall

\$125 Costume Fee- per costume (not including shoes, tights, and undergarments as needed)

Ensembles perform at the Gala Fundraiser in November.

The Gala Fundraiser pays for the choreography for competition pieces.

Each dancer will be responsible for obtaining **two** auction items for the silent auction during the Gala and selling **four** tickets to the event. (These can be parent tickets.)

If this cannot be done a cash donation for ensembles can be made for \$250.

Each parent is responsible for signing up for **at least** one committee.

These committees are to ensure that the Ensembles have the best possible organized year. These committees also ensure parent involvement. Parent involvement is essential for the Gala so that the maximum amount of money can be raised so that the choreography fee can be waived.
